A card will be placed by your tree with the designer's name(s), tree title and benefiting organization. The bidding will take place throughout the day and close at 4:00pm. In addition, there will be a pop-up booth at the 39th Annual Craft Fair at GVHS where pictures of the trees will be up and bid boxes available. Winners will be contacted the evening of November 19 to schedule pickup.

Christmas Tree Blind Auction Participation Guidelines

Thank you for your sharing your time and talent by decorating a Christmas tree/wreath for the Holidays in Grand Valley Christmas Tree Blind Auction. Your participation will help to illuminate the holiday season in a special way for the Parachute/Battlement Mesa community. Registration forms are due by no later than Friday, November 11th at 5:00 pm.

Below is a list of participation guidelines.

- Participation form submitted to Rochelle Firth at rochellemorrison1@gmail.com or to Town Hall, 222 Grand Valley Way. This form is required to ensure that your item has the appropriate signage when it is on display at the auction.
- Materials and labor required to acquire and decorate the tree are your contribution to the auction. All decorations, lights, and trim must be tied securely to the tree. Twist ties or floral wire works well.
- Ornament caps are recommended to be glued to the ornament. Hot glue works well. It is recommended that glue be applied to caps prior to tree decorating.
- We recommend trees have lights. Remember to check the lights before tying them to your entry.
- We encourage you to choose a theme, but artistic creativity and imagination should always take precedence over theme.

The following items are NOT permitted on a tree:

Flammable materials, unwrapped candy or food items, candles, firearm accessories, tobacco, perishable food or materials, X-rated materials.

A card will be placed by your tree with the designer's name(s) and tree title and benefiting organization. Trees will be on display at the Shops at Village Center Who Ville Christmas Market with a pop-up booth display at Grand Valley High School on November 19th.

The blind auction will open for bidding at 9:00 am and close for bidding at 4:00 pm at each location. Winning bidders will be contacted the evening of the 19th. Pick up of winning trees will need to be done at the Shops at Village Center 71 Sippelle Drive. Payment will need to be in the form of a check or money order made out to the charity the tree/wreath was made for.
